KEY BENEFITS

Buddleja are an asset to any garden. They are the first proven breeding line, with plants growing more compactly and easily kept to under 1.5 metres in height with little light pruning'. *Buddleja BUZZ*™ attract butterflies, small birds and insects. Cultivars releases so far are: 'Hot Raspberry' (b)*, 'Ivory', 'Midnight', 'Purple' (b), 'Sky Blue' (b), 'Soft Pink' and 'Velvet' (b).

ORIGIN

The parents of *Buddleja BUZZ*™ are from the open forests of China where, over the centuries *Buddleja davidii* have hybridised readily in nature. This makes the species diverse with various colour forms and various sized bushes being found growing in the natural settings. Plant collectors selected from this wide and diverse group when collecting. *Buddleja BUZZ*™ are a real breeding break through. The breeders at Thompson & Morgan in the United Kingdom selected *Buddleja BUZZ*™ for dwarf growth, masses of blooms and good flower colour.

USES

Buddleja BUZZ™ are great for growing in pots or in various sunny positions in the garden. *Buddleja BUZZ*™ are terrific as a massed border planting or in a mixed garden in full sun to partial shade. Featured in massed plantings they do not disappoint. *Buddleja* flowers look good in spring floral decorations lasting for several days when mixed with other complimentary flowers and foliage.

CARE

The *Buddleja* family is well known to most gardeners and are easy to grow in sunny to semi-shaded positions. Flowers are almost constant year round in most climates giving a splash of colour and good perfume. *Buddleja BUZZ*™ are well behaved plants growing only to a 1.5metre in height with a little pruning. If planting in a large pot, use a good quality potting mixture. Garden soils should be well prepared with cultivation of the area and adding garden compost to the mix. Most soil types are suitable; an application of a complete fertiliser to the garden bed in spring after the main pruning promotes vigorous growth. In winter temperatures to 5°C are tolerated but heavy frosts will cut them back. During the year trim back the older growth when flowers are showing signs of slowing off and getting smaller. The use of a slow release fertiliser is recommended for pot grown specimens.
