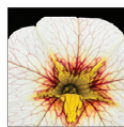

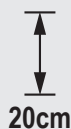

## Calibrachoa Superbells®

### Calibrachoa Hybrid

#### KEY BENEFITS

This new generation of **Superbells** excel. Hundreds of flowers cover the bush from late winter until well into the following autumn. With a selection of stunning and distinctive bright colours to choose from, superbells are a popular choice for gardens and pots.

**Superbells** are easy to grow in any well-draining top quality media. Like all of the *Calibrachoa* family, proper watering is the key to growing **Superbells** well.

#### ORIGIN

The first plants of *Calibrachoa* were taxonomically described only in 1989, not long ago. The first cultivars were released to market in 1992. The original plants were found in coastal areas clinging to rocks and surviving in some pretty harsh conditions. They so much resembled Petunias that they were originally referred to as 'Seashore Petunias'. The family tree of this genus reaches deep into South America, almost all species found in Argentina, Brazil or Uruguay. There are 25 known species. Breeding is complex as all varieties are not compatible.

#### USES

In any size container or hanging basket, **Superbells** excel. The habit of **Superbells** will see them spill over the edge of the container to produce a waterfall of colour. Ideally suited for use in combination either with other colour **Superbells** or different plants altogether like 'Go Go' Salvias or *Lobularia* 'Snow Princess'

#### CARE

Keeping all plants of **Superbells** too wet can lead to root diseases. Allow the top of the soil to dry before watering again. If your plant wilts even though the soil is still moist you very likely have a root problem through excess watering. Always look for Superbells in the nursery and do not accept substitutes. All **Superbells** are bred for hardiness against root rot diseases and outperform against other series on the market hands down.

#### FERTILISER ADVICE

Throughout the growing season from September until April apply flower boosting liquid fertiliser rather than one high in nitrogen, which will encourage foliage at the expense of flowers. Light pruning at any time can be done to keep the plant to the size you need for your container or garden position.
